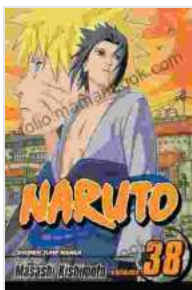


Naruto Vol 38: Practice Makes Perfect: Naruto Graphic Novel

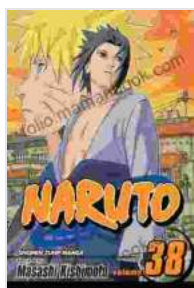

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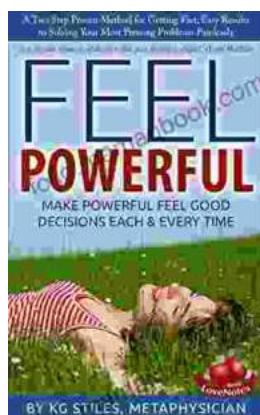
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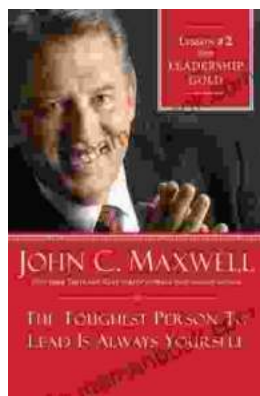
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
