CCPAJ publishes a wide range of scholarly and creative works, including:

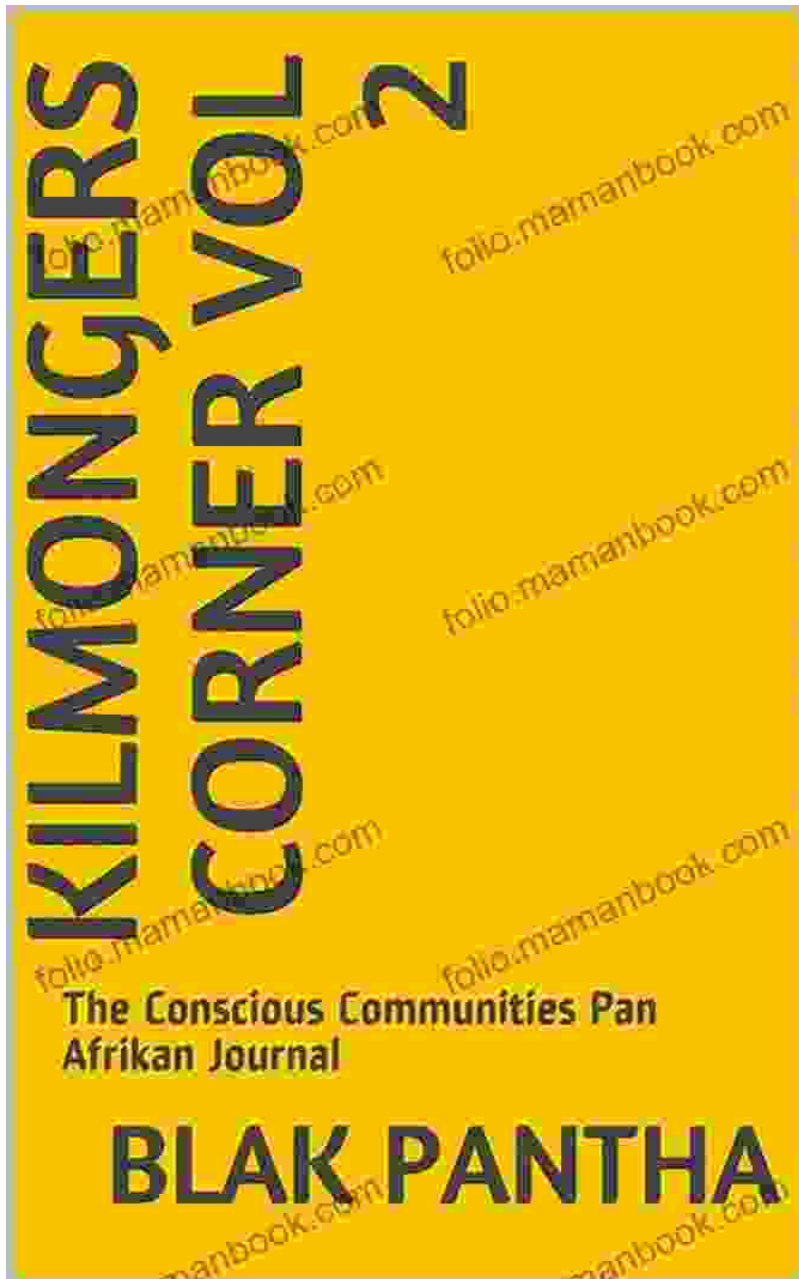
- Research articles addressing social, cultural, and economic issues affecting the African diaspora.

- Book reviews and interviews that highlight important scholarship and engage with the ideas shaping the field.

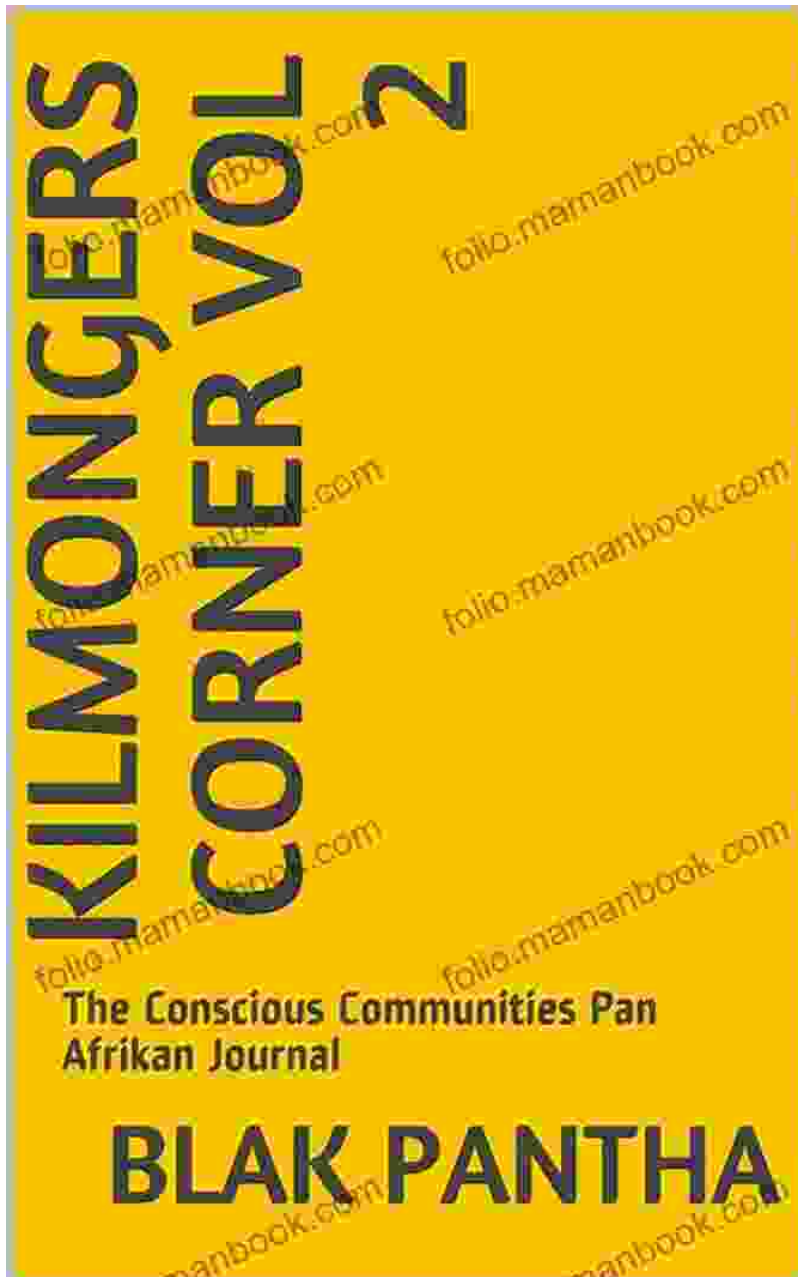
CCPAJ's interdisciplinary approach fosters a diverse range of perspectives and encourages scholars and activists from various backgrounds to engage in dialogue.

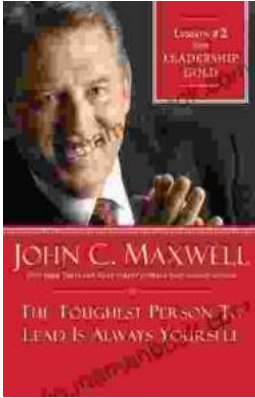
